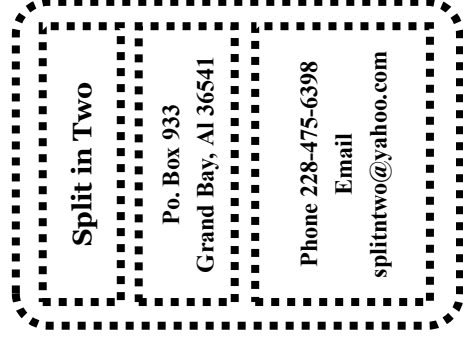

and legislators.

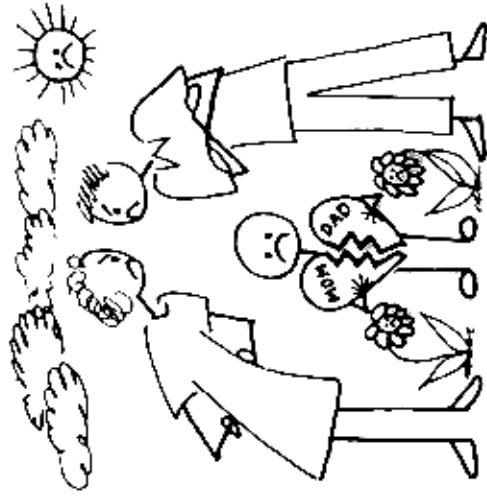

### Parental alienation

Is the mental manipulation of children, which can result in destroying a loving and warm relationship they once shared with a parent. Parental Alienation Syndrome, or PAS for short, is the programming of children against one of the parents. Through verbal and non verbal thoughts, actions and mannerisms, a child is emotionally abused (brainwashed) into thinking the other parent is the enemy.

The effect is to produce a disturbance in the child's relationship with the other parent

Parental Alienation can occur in intact families, but is mostly seen in separated and divorced families.



### What to look for

In the first stages of Parental Alienation Syndrome it is most important to be aware of the signs. Here are just a few signs to watch out for .

- A parent threatens to abduct the children.
- Refusing the other parent access to medical and school records or schedules of activities;
- A parent interferes with a reasonable number of calls
- A campaign of demigration and programming
- Access time is not occurring as agreed upon or court ordered - visitation is being unilaterally cut back or withheld by the other parent

## Here are some of The Facts



Persistent feelings of betrayal, rejection, rage, guilt, pain

Two-thirds of alienated children yearned for the absent parent, one-half of those with a profound intensity

Children do not naturally lose interest in and become

distant from their nonresidential parent simply by virtue

Parental programming was practiced to varying degrees

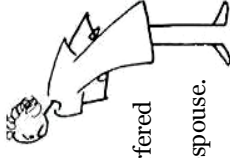
by 80% of divorcing parents, with 20% of engaging in such behaviors with their children at least once a day.

50% of mothers see no value in continued

contact with a father and his children.

40% of mothers reported that they had interfered

with the fathers visitation to punish their ex-spouse.



77% of non-custodial fathers are not able

to "visit" their children, as ordered by the

court as a result of "visitation interference".



75% of teens who commit suicide live with only one parent

69% of PAS victims experience psychological distress

(defined as anxiety, sadness, pronounced moodiness, phobias, and depression)

56% Poor grades or grades substantially below ability

and/or recent past performance

As 90% of the children involved in high conflict custody battles show symptoms of PAS

Approximately 20 million children are victims of PAS.

With one of every two marriages ending in divorce,

another 25 million children will face some form of PAS.

Understanding PAS and how to address it is critical if

children of divorce are to enjoy the emotional benefits of

loving, healthy, relationships with both parents and their

extended families and to grow up with the ability to form

loving and stable relationships with other adults.

### PAS victims are children and families

The child experiences a great loss, the magnitude of

which is akin to death of a parent, two grandparents,

and all the lost parent's relatives and friends.. Moreover,

the child is unable to acknowledge the loss, much less

mourn it" The child's good memories of the alienated

parent are systematically destroyed and the child misses

out on the day-to-day interaction, learning, support and

love which, in an intact family, usually flows between the

child and both parents, as well as grandparents and other

relatives on both sides.

**We do not favor sole custody when both parents are fit. We believe that children of divorce or**

**separation deserve the right to be raised equally by both parents.**
